

LADNER MEN'S 0/35 SOCCER LEAGUE

Rules & Regulations 2007

BOND

A refundable Bond of \$100.00 for the current season is to be paid at the time of Registration. This Bond is apart from the fees for the Operating Expenses of the League.

ELIGIBLE PLAYERS

A team must consist of players of the age of 35 years or older but the team is allowed to play a maximum of three players under the age of 35 years but not younger than 30 years of age. The goalkeeper is the only player who can be of any age.

CANCELLATION OF GAMES

In the event that a team has advanced knowledge that it can not field a team for a scheduled game than that team must give the league 24 hours notice.

Failure to notify the league maybe subject to a Fine of \$50.00.

In the event that a team is at the field and it can not play the scheduled game due to an insufficient number of players, the opposing team will get the three (3) points. Both teams may play an exhibition game and each team pays the \$25.00 Referee fee. If no exhibition game is played then the team which forfeits the game is responsible for the \$50.00 referee's fee.

LINING OF GRASS FIELDS

The fields will be lined. If a field is found not to be lined the referee must inform the league.

DISCIPLINE

One (1) red card is one (1) game suspension and a Fine of \$25.00, unless the league deems that a greater suspension is necessary. The player will sit out the remainder of the game and the following game.

Three (3) yellow cards is one (1) game suspension and a Fine of \$25.00.

All Fines must be paid before the Player(s) or the Team's next game.

THREE RED CARDS

If a player accumulates three (3) red cards in a season, that player will be suspended for the remainder of the season and the Play-offs. That player will also be fined \$25.00. If that player fails to pay the assessed Fine, his team will be held responsible for payment of that Fine.

The Fine must be paid no later than at the conclusion of the season.

ASSISTANT REFEREES APPOINTED TO KEY GAMES

If the league deems that certain games require Assistant Referees due to their nature (rivalry, animosity, or any other problems) the League will appoint Assistant Referees to those games. The fees for the officials will be equally shared by both teams. (\$50.00 each team)

ABANDONMENT OF GAME

In the event a referee abandons the game due to a brawl, physical intimidation and or verbal threats to him, the League will investigate the matter. The League will fine the team or both teams a Fine of \$50.00. The league will also determine whether the game will be replayed or if the score remains. At least 75% of the game must have been played and the game be considered completed.

TEAM LISTS AT EACH GAME

All teams are required to submit a Team List to the referee before every game but no later than at the start of the second half of the game. Team Lists must show the complete First and Last names of players and the team name. Players arriving in the second half must have their names added onto the Team List provided to the referee. The Team Lists will be used at the end of the season to determine player eligibility for the playoffs. In order for players to be deemed eligible players must have played at least three (3) games during the season.

PLAY-OFFS

Assistant Referees will be provided and paid for by the League for the Semi-Final and Final games.
